- Tap into relevant job opportunities

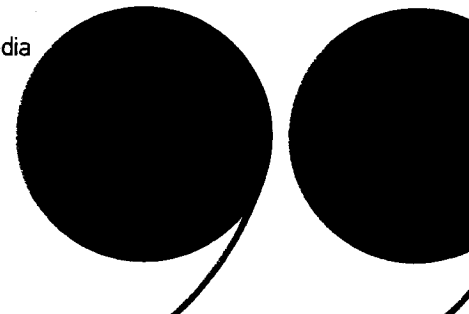

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of 8 years of management or senior professional experience
- Demonstrated fluency in English
- For international applicants whose university degree was not taught in English, the programme requires a minimum band score of 6.5 in IELTS, or the following TOEFL scores:
 - 600 for paper-based tests, or
 - 100 for internet-based tests

CALENDAR

The programme begins with a 1-week orientation period. The first and second trimesters take place from July to February on NTU's Singapore campus. The third term begins in March with a 4-week stay in the United States and ends in Singapore in June.

PROGRAMME FEE

The programme fee is S\$75,000* (excluding GST). It covers tuition at NBS-NTU, University of California, Berkeley, The Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania and Georgetown University; an Overseas Business Study Mission (airfare, transportation, accommodation and certain meals), and examination fees.

- * The fee does not include airfare to or from the participant's country of origin, transportation, or accommodation in Singapore and the United States.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Nanyang Business School offers attractive scholarships to outstanding international candidates with a stellar academic record and exceptional professional experience. Admitted candidates will be considered for scholarships, which will be awarded based on need and qualifications.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

A one-year full-time programme for senior executives from both public and private sectors, the Nanyang Fellows MBA offers an academically rigorous curriculum that addresses the most relevant global economic and management trends and leadership precepts that embrace the best of the East and the West.

The programme combines a variety of academic methods to ensure an interactive and in-depth learning experience.

Nanyang Fellows learn through dynamic lectures, keynote sessions with industry and government leaders, individual and team projects, peer-based learning, overseas study trips and the case study method.

Developed by Harvard Business School, the case study methodology is widely used in executive education. Using this methodology, Nanyang Fellows sharpen their decision-making and analytical skills by examining authentic business scenarios and defending their recommendations to the group.

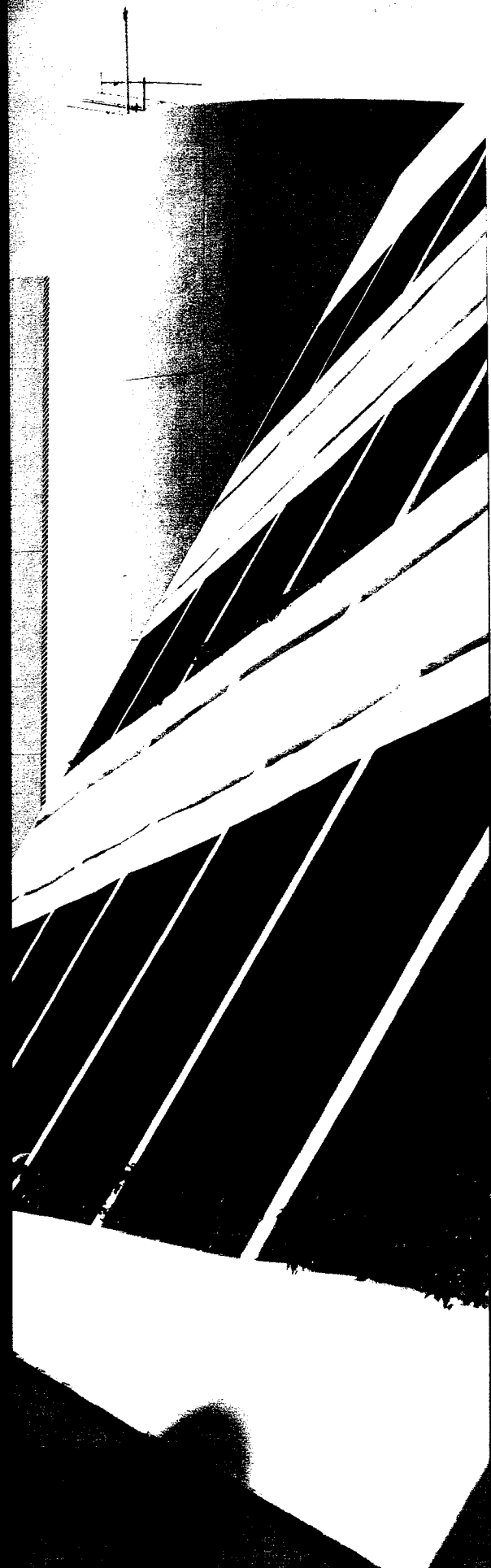
